This program is taught by volunteers or employees of the Connecticut DEP Boating Division and is designed to fulfill the requirements for the Connecticut Safe Boating Certificate and the Personal Watercraft Operator's Certificate. Upon successful completion of the course and final examination, the student can send or carry the diploma, the application for certification, and the appropriate fee to any State DEP office to obtain the Safe Boating Certificate and/or the Personal Watercraft Operator's Certificate. For more information about the licensing process, please visit the website of the Department of Environmental Protection at www.dep.state.ct.us.

You will learn:

- * Safety equipment requirements
- * Environmental awareness
- * Boating regulations
- * Boat launches and local regulations
- * Rules and navigation
- * Safety information
- * Tides and sunrise/sunset data

Qualifications: Students must attend all classes to qualify for the certificate of completion. There is no age requirement, but participants must be able to read and comprehend the material covered to independently take and complete the final exam. No textbook required.

Registration is required—walk-ins will not be allowed as classes do fill prior to the first night.

Directions:

- If you have a Connecticut Hunting or Fishing License, your Conservation ID will be the same ID number that was assigned with the hunting or fishing license.
 If you need a Conservation ID number:
- Go to the Online Sportsman Licensing -(https://ct.outdoorcentral.net/InternetSales)
 Scroll to the bottom of the page and hit START
- 3. Go to the search by personal information- you will need to either put in your ss# or driver's license number to see if you are in the system as having a conservation ID number previously issued to you. If not then you will go to -Select here to receive your conservation ID only for an Education Course Registration, and complete the registration process. Follow the instructions for "New Customers".
- 4. Print out your conservation ID profile and bring it to your class

You will need to give this to the instructor your conservation ID number and your date of birth on the class roster.
